



## **Learn to KinderGym NT**

### **Terms and Conditions of Use**

#### **1. Program**

Learn to KinderGym Northern Territory (**NT**) is part of the approved grant activity by the Northern Territory Government, care of the agency Department of People, Sport and Culture, dated 3 July 2025.

Learn to KinderGym NT is an extension of the Northern Territory Government's Sport Voucher Scheme to provide valuable financial assistance to families supporting children's participation in sport, active recreation and cultural activities.

Learn to KinderGym NT provides a scheme to address the fundamental movement skills in early childhood through structured gymnastics programs.

Participation in the Learn to KinderGym NT scheme is via a voucher only and subject to eligibility criteria.

#### **2. Eligibility**

The Learn to KinderGym NT scheme is valid from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026 and runs until 30 June 2026.

Eligibility criteria to apply for the Learn to KinderGym NT voucher is below:-

- a) Child participating must be aged 1-4 years of age;
- b) Child participating must reside in Northern Territory;
- c) Activity provider must be registered as a participating Learn to KinderGym NT location;
- d) No prior completion of a trial or class undertaken (unless prior approval via Gymnastics NT sought) at the participating Learn to KinderGym NT locations; Darwin Gymnastic Club, Marrara, Elemental Gymnastics Club, Woolner and Territory Gymnastics Academy, Winnellie
- e) One voucher per child only.

#### **3. How to Apply**

Parents/carers of children who are under the age of 4 and are not enrolled in school are eligible to apply for a maximum of one voucher as part of the Learn to KinderGym NT



scheme. Voucher valued at \$100 and allows 5 x KinderGym sessions as per club programs

The vouchers are available for application from 1 January 2026 and are issued and managed electronically by Gymnastics Northern Territory through [Jotform](#).

- a) Parents / carers must apply for the Learn to KinderGym NT voucher online at Jotform: <https://form.jotform.com/260200528511039>
- b) Parents / carers must complete the required video activity before obtaining the voucher online;
- c) The scheme operates until the end of June 2026 or until funding capacity is reached;
- d) Learn to KinderGym NT vouchers can only be redeemed at approved Activity Providers that are participating Learn to KinderGym NT locations;
- e) Each participant enrolled in a session due to the use of a voucher must be registered with the approved Activity Provider to participate in the applicable gymsport sessions available to them;
- f) Vouchers cannot be transferred to another child;
- g) Vouchers cannot be collected by Activity Providers not registered with the scheme, even in anticipation of being registered;
- h) Vouchers can only be used for gymnastics activity related to children under 4 years of age at participating Learn to KinderGym NT Activity Providers; Darwin Gymnastic Club, Marrara, Elemental Gymnastics Club, Woolner and Territory Gymnastics Academy, Winnellie;
- i) Activity Providers must be registered or approved by Gymnastics Northern Territory to participate in the scheme.

#### **4. Expiry**

All vouchers expire within the year of the date of issue.

#### **5. Redemption**

All vouchers are unique and must be presented at the time of booking before attending the chosen session at the participating Learn to KinderGym NT location.

All vouchers online, single use only, one per child per Activity Provider.

The receipt of a voucher does not confirm participation in the Learn to KinderGym NT program until a booking is made to attend an approved Activity Provider.

All vouchers are not exchangeable for cash, tender or money of any kind.



All vouchers are subject to demand and class availability.

## **6. Transferability**

No vouchers under the Learn to KinderGym NT scheme are transferable for any other service that is not related to gymnastics activities in participating Learn to KinderGym NT locations as approved Activity Providers.

Activity Providers may not transfer the services set out under the voucher for any other service than that approved under these terms and conditions.

## **7. Restrictions**

All voucher recipients must be new to gymnastics as an activity.

One voucher per child must be presented at the time of booking a session at the participating Learn to KinderGym NT location as an approved Activity Provider.

Existing participants in a Learn to KinderGym NT location may not use this voucher to attend another Activity Provider whereby they already participate in gymnastics Activities.

Vouchers may not be used for the redemption of food, drink, birthday parties, events, products or goods and services other than to participate in an enrolled gym sport at the chosen participating Learn to KinderGym NT location as an Activity Provider approved under these terms and conditions.

## **8. Payment**

No payment is required for the use of the voucher for any participants or the approved Activity Providers. Payment may be required for other activities, memberships or continued classes with the participating Learn to KinderGym NT location.

## **9. Value**

Any value-add services attached to the voucher may be subject to existing terms and conditions and the approval of Gymnastics Northern Territory. The voucher allows for 5 x KinderGym sessions.

## **10. Data Collection & Privacy**

All data (including personal data) collected and shared during the Learn to KinderGym NT scheme participation of participants, parent / guardians, gymnastics clubs and organisations will be collected in consideration of the privacy rights of the individuals. Data (including personal data) may be used for relevant third parties where required by law and we will not provide intentional access to such data unless compelled to do so.

## 12. Activity Providers

### *Eligibility criteria*

For the Activity Providers to be listed as a participating Learn to KinderGym NT location must:-

- a) Be affiliated with Gymnastics Northern Territory and Gymnastics Australia;
- b) Be listed and approved as an approved Activity Provider
- c) Carry and hold a certificate of currency (public liability insurance) for not less than \$30million for any single event;
- d) An organisation that is a going concern (solvent) based on audited financial statements or accountancy report;
- e) Demonstrated an awareness and application of obligations relating the *Northern Territory Care and Protection of Children Act 2007*, in particular with regards to mandatory reporting;
- f) Ensure that relevant staff and volunteers (including committee members and the primary applicant) delivering services under the scheme have a valid Working with Children Clearance, including maintaining a register of staff and volunteer Working with Children Clearance Cards. ### *Goods and Services Tax*

Vouchers are valued at \$100 GST inclusive and this must be reflected in the value of the goods and services offered. GST registered Activity Providers will be reimbursed up to \$100 GST inclusive for each voucher. Gymnastics Northern Territory (**GNT**) will provide all Activity Providers with a recipient created tax invoice (**RCTI**). It is the Activity Providers responsibility to notify GNT of their GST status and if there is ever any change of status, and therefore the RCTI should reflect this at all times.



## **Compliance**

To enable reviews or audits to be completed quickly, registered Activity Providers should ensure proper record keeping procedures are maintained and that documentation is available for review. Risk reviews and audits may also provide GNT with information that can be used to modify and improve the scheme policy and procedures, participation data in general and billing for participation of gymnastics activities throughout the scheme period.
